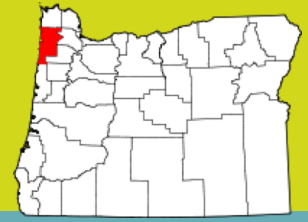






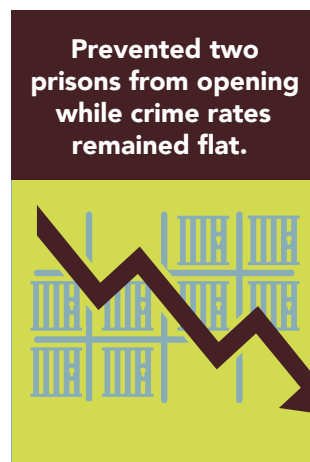
# Justice Reinvestment in Tillamook County



Tillamook County received a Justice Reinvestment grant in the amount of **\$298,956** for 2017-2019 to support the following:

-  **SAFETY** Thorough risk assessments and evidence-based tools used to develop case plans for effective transition from jail to community-based services.
-  **ACCOUNTABILITY** People receive enhanced supervision and case management.
-  **TREATMENT** Funds are used for addiction treatment, cognitive behavior treatment, stable housing, and employment referral services.
-  **VICTIM SERVICES** Ten percent of the county's Justice Reinvestment funds are used to support victims of domestic and sexual violence and child abuse.

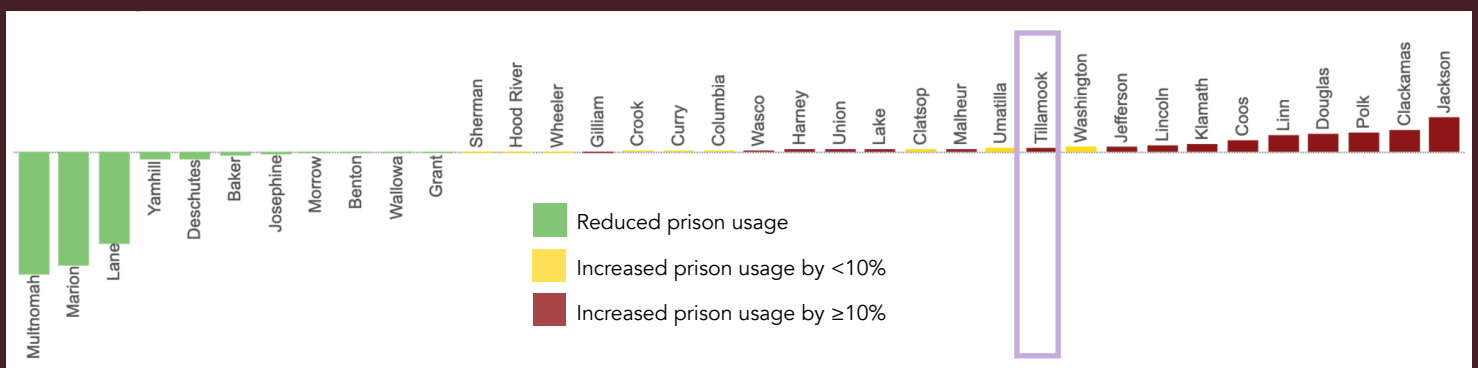
